DIRECTION FOR.....

*Put a table-spoon full of Liqueur.....
into a tumbler add gradually twice.....of
water, allow it to remain for enough.....the
tumbler with water when thus prepared.....be
found a pleasant appetizing and stimulating beverage.*

EXTRACT OF ANALYSIS

*From the result of my examination and analysis I find
